


# **WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices**

## September 2015



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

#### **WSU Current Index of Economic Activity**

The current index improved somewhat between June and July, reversing previous declines. This brought the current level of economic activity above the 2014 level. The improvement can be attributed to the increase in total non-farm employment. This was offset by deteriorations in the other index components.

#### **WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity**

The leading index improved slightly between June and July and continues to indicate there will be a decrease in economic activity through the end of the year. This will potentially bring economic activity below the 2014 level. There have been slight improvements in the Kansas Leading Index and National Industrial Production Index, but not enough to offset the current downward trend.
