


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

May 2016



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index deteriorated slightly between February and March, after improving at the beginning of the year. The current level of economic activity, in Wichita, remains somewhat above the 2015 level. There were improvements in total employment and the unemployment rate that were offset by deteriorations in the hours and earnings of production employees.

WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity

The leading index was unchanged between February and March. There continues to be an indication of decreased economic activity through late summer. There were strong improvements in the Aircraft Production Index and the Kansas Leading Index. However, these improvements were offset by declines in the National Industrial Production Index and the International Leading Index.
