


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

August 2018

The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.



WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index increased slightly in August2018. The current level of economic activity is above the 2017 level. There was an increase in total employment, while the unemployment rate declined. Hours of production employees decreased, and weekly earnings of production employees increased.
