

- Monitor compliance of the Regulatory Flexibility Act (1980).
- Analyze economic impacts of proposed federal regulations on small businesses.
- Conduct economic research on small business issues.
- Sponsor and disseminate small business statistics.










#### Change in employment by employer size

#### Change in total business applications




Applications summed over 5 weeks. Change from 52 weeks prior. Shading indicates a recessionary period.



### **Employment changes within leisure and hospitality**






