



Total Nonfarm - Lawrence MSA -Total Nonfarm Employment (in thousands, not seasonally adjusted)





Unemployment Rate - Douglas County, KS - Civiliand Labor Force (not seasonally adjusted)



## Seasonally Adjusted Retail Sales





## **Business Dynamism Index**


• The index measures the dynamism of the business environment in three areas: industry diversification, business expansion, and labor churn.







## Kansas Business Dynamism Index, 2021










Douglas County ranked 8<sup>th</sup> highest overall in the state.




