


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

November 2014



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index continued to improve slightly between August and September, bringing the current level of economic activity in Wichita 0.2 percent above where it was in September of 2013. This improvement can be attributed to the growth in total non-farm employment, which is now 0.6 percent above the September 2013 level. This growth in employment has been helped by a 0.1 percent decrease in the unemployment rate.

WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity

The leading index continues to predict small improvements in economic activity through the winter. This can be attributed to the continued improvement in the Aircraft Production Index. The National Industrial Production Index improved between August and September, after being down between July and August.
