


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

April 2018

The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.



WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index stayed the same in April 2018, after declining in January and February. The current level of economic activity is above the 2017 level. There was a decrease in total employment, while the unemployment rate stayed flat. Hours of production employees, and weekly earnings of production employees both increased.
