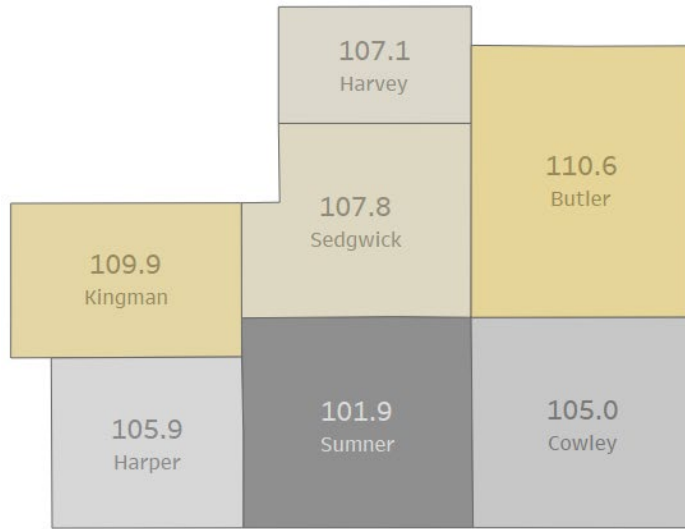

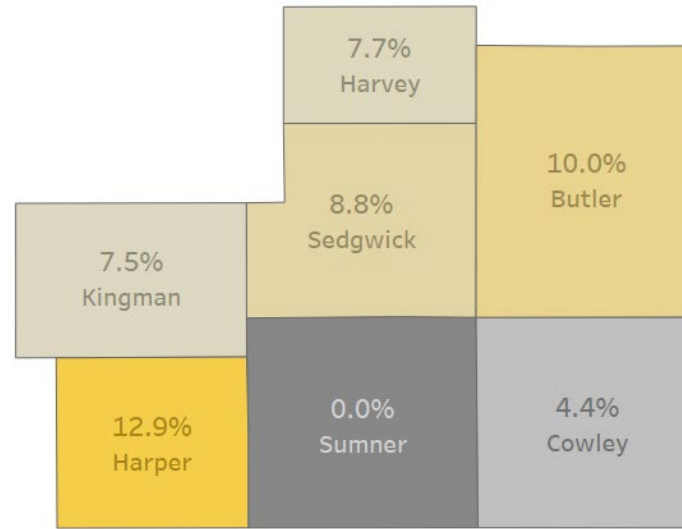

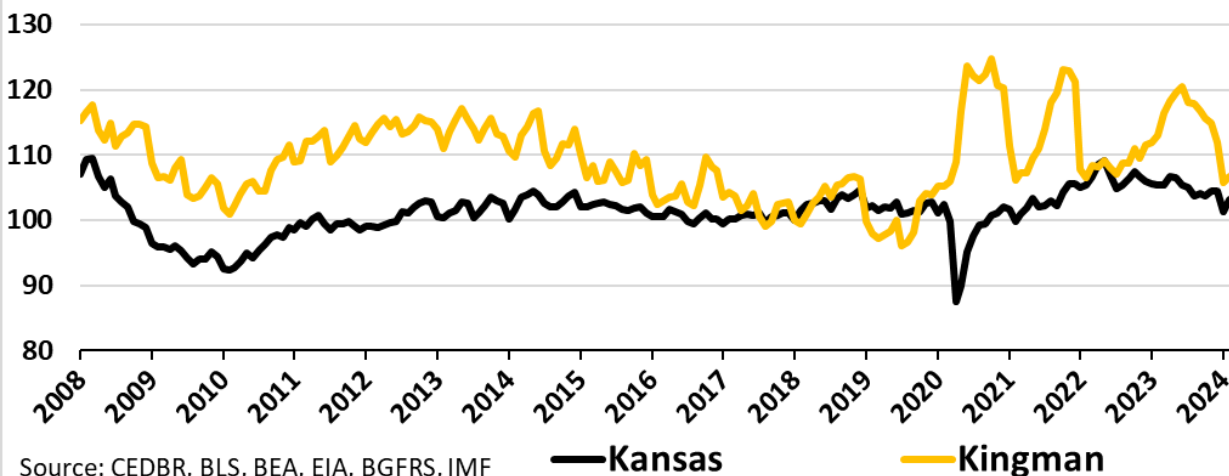


Y/Y Current Index Growth – 2022-23

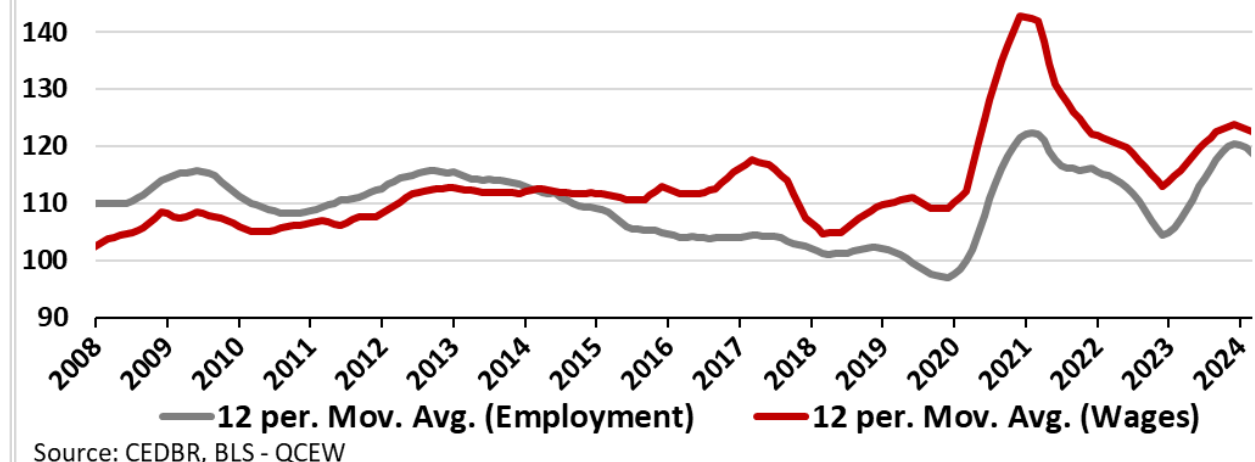


- Regionally, all counties are better off than in 2018 (the base year)

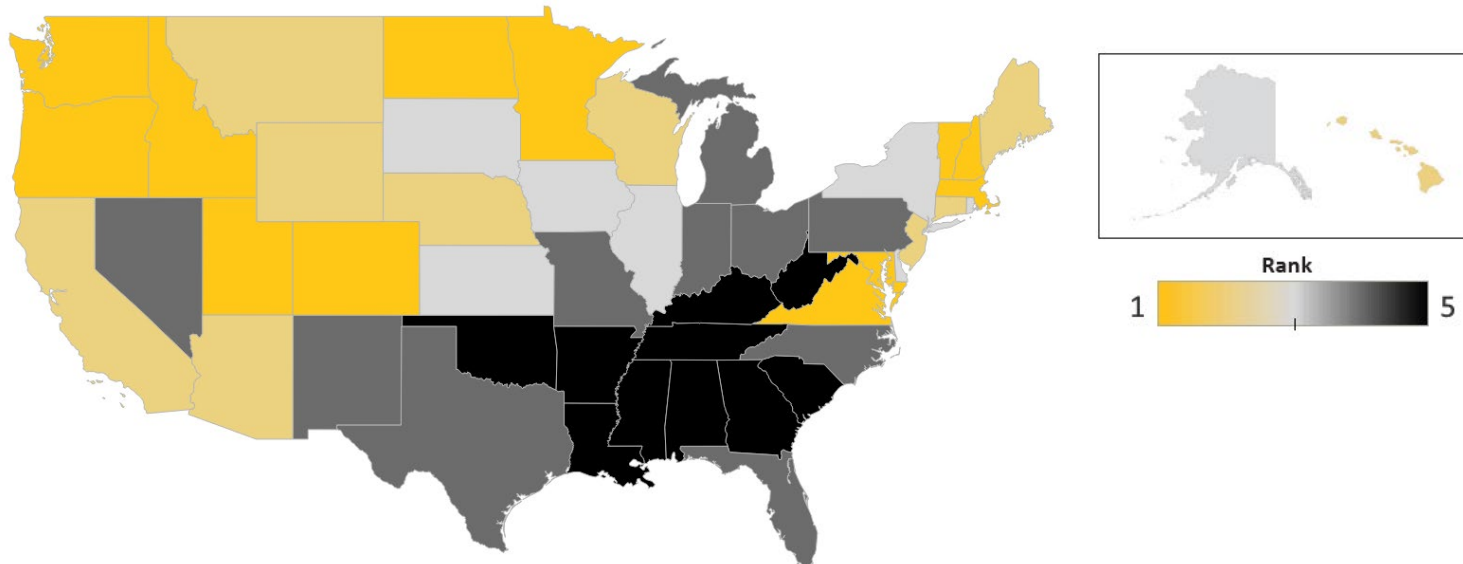

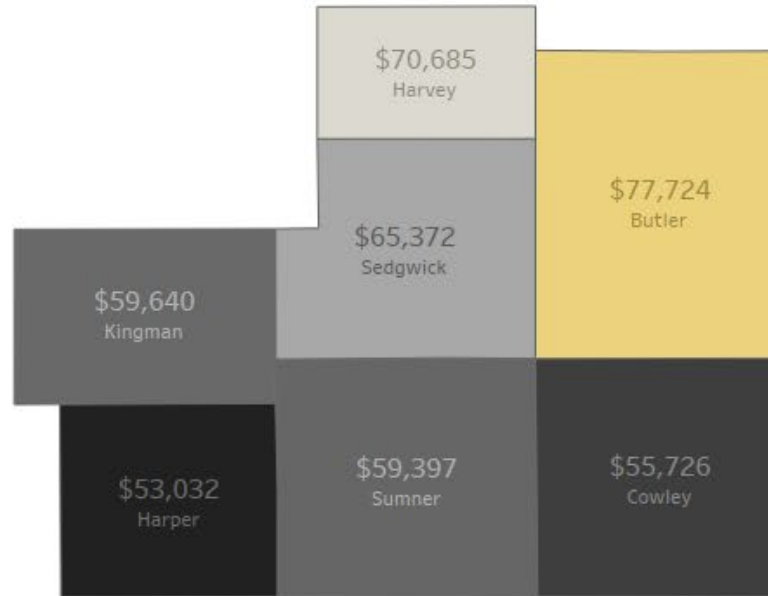

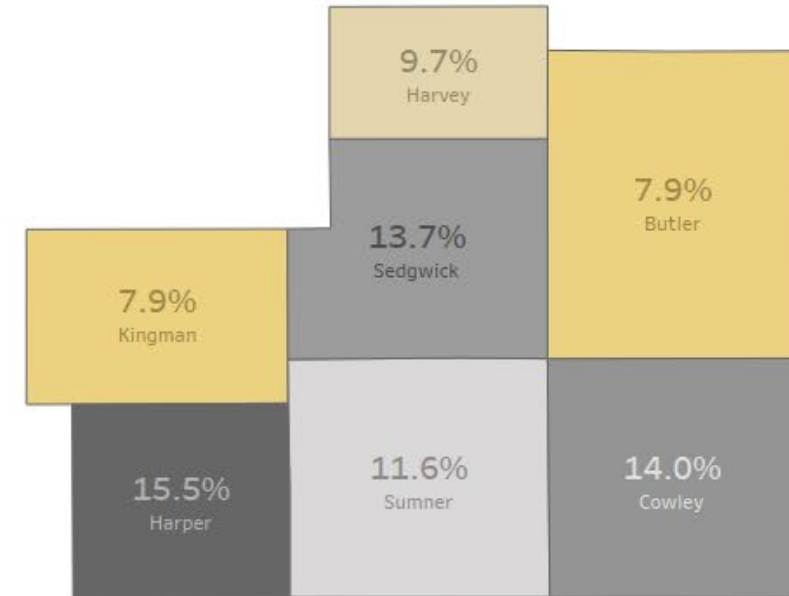

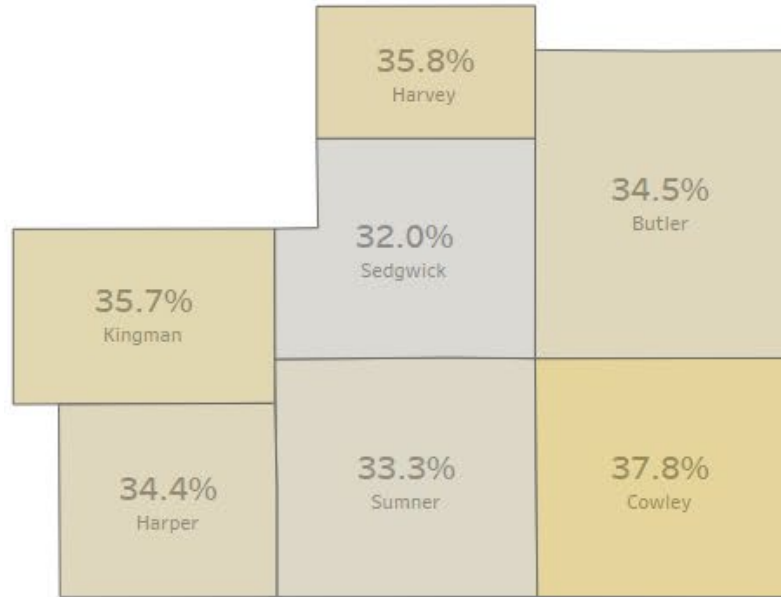


Wise — Remains concentrated in technical and associate degrees, but overall educational attainment is falling

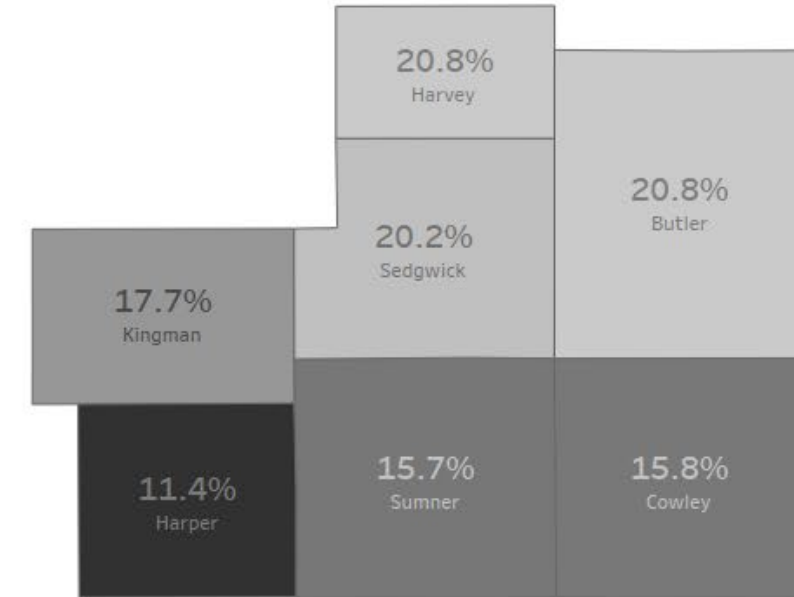
